BOTTLED BEER SELECTION

Australia

Cooper's Best Extra Stout

Style: Export Stout (6.3% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This top fermented stout offers a unique rich and dark texture that is given off by specialty roasted malts. The flavor is spot on with an authentic Irish Dry Stout with flavors of roasted malt, bitter coffee and chocolate.

Cooper's Vintage Ale

Style: English Strong Ale (7.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This ale has been brewed with choice malts and an extended top fermentation to provide strong flavorsome ale. The Vintage Ale is stored under cellar conditions giving it a lot of complexity over an extended period of time.

Austria

Hofstetten Granitbock

Style: Doppelbock (7.3%ABV)

Size: 16.9 oz

Notes: Pours hazy dark amber-brown with a lasting off-white head. Aroma is nice caramel malt, bready and toasty, with dark fruit hints. The flavor is moderately sweet caramel, yeast, dark fruit and hints of chocolate in the finish. This is definitely one of the better Doppelbocks out these days.

Reider Classic

Style: German Pilsner (5.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: A hazy yellow pour with a sheet white head that retains well, and leaves a sliding lace down the glass. The smell is very earthy and floral which leads to a wonderful pilsner taste, almost of a sourdough flavor. This is nice and crisp with a great hop finish.

Reider XXX Weisse

Style: Weizenbock (6.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This will pour a deeply vibrant orange-gold topped with a highly assertive rocky white head. A lot of spice is found in the nose, followed by pronounced flavors of banana, clove, roasted malt and heavy caramel in the finish.

Belgium

Brasserie Caracole Nostradamus

Style: Belgian Brown Ale (9.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: The nose on this beer is beautiful, offering a pleasant combination of figs, caramel, toffee and maple syrup. The first sip is of subtly sweet caramel notes, toasted tree nuts, winter spices and enough malt and Belgian yeast notes to round off incredible flavor.

Brasserie Caracole Saxo

Style: Belgian Blonde Ale (7.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This is a Belgian Blonde Ale whose color is a deep golden hue, almost brown, which is rare to find in a beer of this category. The flavor offers a unique blend of Belgian hops, slight bitterness and a touch of spice crowned with a sumptuous fluffy white head.

Brasserie Caracole Troulette

Style: Witbier (5.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This pours a cloudy bright orange with a sumptuous snow white head. It is lightly spiced with great complexity, starting off with aromas of mango, apple, citric fruit, and wheat with a subtle tart finish.

Brasserie d'Achouffe La Chouffe

Style: Belgian Golden Ale (8.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This ale will pour a hazy yellow-golden color garnished with a tremendous head. It is unfiltered, re-fermented, with fruity spiced notes and a touch of coriander.

Brugs Zot Blonde

Style: Belgian Pale Ale (6.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This brewery was renovated and re-established in 2005, and we're sure glad they did. They launched this Pale Ale as a flagship beer, and it is truly a solid choice. This beer has everything that one would expect from a Belgian brewery, wonderful golden pour, white pillowy head, and a nice nose of sweet grains, malts and crisp Belgian yeast. This moderately carbonated beer has with a touch alcohol and hop bitterness to the taste that is overall incredibly drinkable.

Brugse Zot Dubbel

Style: Belgian Dubbel (7.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: The people of Brugge, Belgium are nicknamed 'Brugse Zotten' which translates to 'Brugge Fools'. Fools certainly brewed this great dubbel. Its easy drinkability is a true testament to the style. Aromas of toffee, dates and figs are at the forefront, with mild chocolate and butterscotch to follow. The taste is refreshingly mild, unlike many Trappist styles, and the aromas of chocolate follow through with a fruity and nutty background. Its carbonation level leaves a lively mouth feel without going over the top.

Cherish Kriek Lambic

Style: Fruit Lambic (5% ABV)

Size: 8.4 oz

Notes: A vibrant, bold red body is topped with a fizzy pink head, enriched with a bouquet of wild cherry. The flavor follows this pattern closely, offering a finish reminiscent of boozy cherry juice. A slight oaked note might come through, but the fruit flavor out duels everything else.

Chimay Blue

Style: Belgian Strong Dark Ale (9.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This is top-fermented ale that is then re-fermented in the bottle whose fragrance is of fresh yeast with a light, flowery rosy touch. Its flavor only accentuates the pleasant sensations perceived in the aroma, while revealing a light but pleasant touch of roasted malt.

Chimay Red

Style: Abbey Dubbel (7.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This is noted for its coppery color which makes it very attractive. Topped with a beautiful creamy head, it gives off a fruity apricot nose produced by the fermentation. The taste is very complex with a harmonious mouth feel that finishes slightly bitter.

Chimay White

Style: Tripel (8.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This beer, with its typical golden color, its slightly hazy appearance and its fine head is especially characterized by its aroma which results from an agreeable combination of fresh hops and yeast.

Corsendonk Abbey Brown Ale

Style: Dubbel (7.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This will pour a deep maroon color, with a well retained head and descent lacing. Aroma is of dark fruits, with a malty taste with subtle flavors of raisin, maple syrup and dark chocolate.

Corsendonk Abbey Pale Ale

Style: Abbey Tripel (7.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This beer will pour an interesting dark brown-red color with flavors of Belgian clove, candied malts, and grain. Plenty of carbonation forms as it sits on your tongue, finishing with notes of coriander and spices.

Delirium Nocturnum

Style: Belgian Strong Dark Ale (8.5% ABV)

Notes: This pours a ruby-brown with an off white foamy head that never seems to dissipate. The aroma is one of baking chocolate, caramel and light fruit. The taste is of nutty malts, chocolate, raisins and a hint of the alcohol.

Delirium Tremens

Style: Belgian Strong Pale Ale (9.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This ale is light, but full bodied. Full bodied, yet light. Signature Belgian notes of clove and coriander form on your palate, with a finish of banana, spices and citrus flavors. A creamy white head forms on every pour and lingers around even after the first few sips. Beautiful lacing forms to the sides of the glass as your snifter progressively becomes empty.

DeuS

Style: Bier de Champagne (11.0% ABV)

Size: 750ml

Notes: This is an interesting beer that is argued whether this is indeed a beer or not. Brewed with the methode Champenoise, this ale is highly carbonated with light, refreshing flavors and offers notes of anise, fresh malt and herbal hops.

Duchesse De Bourgogne

Style: Flanders Red Ale (6.2% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This will pour a deep reddish-brown color crowned with a white head with consistent lacing. Slightly sour aromas hit the senses first, followed by flavors heavily acidic fruit, oak, sour cherry and caramel malt. This is finished with a wild yeast strain, giving it an extra tart finish.

Duvel Ale

Style: Belgian Strong Pale Ale (8.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: Flemish for devil, this triple-fermented ale is uncommon in so many great ways. Regarded by many to be the best Belgian Golden Ale available, it has champagne-like carbonation and a tart, lemony background combined with a malty finish.

Ename Tripel

Style: Tripel (8.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: The Ename will showcase a slightly hazed golden hue, dressed with an assertive white head with generous carbonation. Its aroma and flavor will feature notes of sweetened malt, clove, coriander, honey and a touch of apricot.

Green's Discovery Gluten Free Amber Ale

Style: English Strong Ale (6% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This is a beer without gluten or any other ingredients that have been known to cause damage. Medium-bodied with subtle caramel and nut flavor nuances. Refined, herbal hop aroma and finish. This is about as healthy as you can get with beer.

Gulden Draak

Style: Dark Belgian Tripel (10.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This is a dark brown triple ale, which makes it an exception among the Belgian triples. This beer is re-fermented in the bottle, giving it a beautiful creamy head. This ale balances a natural malt toffee-like sweetness with some hoppy accents.

Hanssens Oude Gueuze

Style: Lambic-Geuze (6% ABV)

Size: 12.7 oz

Notes: As with all Gueuzes, Hanssens is a mixture of several vintages to produce a lambic which is refreshingly fruity with tart flavor and a nice dry finish. This is the result of blending many different lambics of different ages. The second fermentation takes place inside the bottles and therefore they are stored for a minimum of six months in constant temperature kept cellars.

Hanssens Oudbeitje Lambic

Style: Lambic (6% ABV)

Size: 12.7 oz

The pour is a dark hazy straw yellow with no head as a result of little carbonation. The aromas upfront are of strong acidity, funk and an extreme tart presence. The taste is wonderfully unexpected, with no real strawberry fruit flavor until the after taste lingers in the mouth. This is a true Belgian Lambic: heavy tart flavor, heavy acid taste.

Het Anker Lucifer

Style: Belgian Strong Pale Ale (8.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: A slightly hazed golden color is topped with a massive pale white head that lingers slowly. A grassy hop aroma is present, followed by smooth display of pear, lemon citrus, Belgian hop, sweet malt and spices.

La Trappe Isid'or

Style: Belgian Pale Ale (7.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: One of the great Trappist monk breweries. This is semi dark, with a burnt orange body is decorated with an assertive beige head enriched with aromas of clove, banana and caramel. These notes are found in the finish as well, alongside other flavors of caramelized sugar, honey and sweet malt.

Leffe Blonde

Style: Belgian Pale Ale (6.6% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This is very solid session ale even with its high levels of carbonation. The pour is a nice golden color with a bright white head, typical of its Belgian style. The taste is fruity up front with a nice malt backbone and subtle hints of spice in the finish.

Malheur 12

Style: Belgian Quadrupel (12.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This ale pours a deep reddish-brown with a creamy head that lasts. The aroma is of ripe fruit, both apricots and figs. The flavor is complex, with the presence of prunes, grapes, citrus and vanilla with a strong malt backdrop with a light hop for balance.

Orval

Style: Belgian Pale Ale (6.9% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: A full flavored, effervescent top-fermenting trappist ale with intriguing sour notes delivered from the use of a wild yeast strain known as brettanomyces. This is the only trappist ale that uses this strain of yeast, making it very different amongst the rest.

Petrus Gouden Triple Ale

Style: Triple Golden Ale (7.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: Fermented with three times the amount of barley malt, this triple offers a very easy-going flavor with subtle hoppy taste, balanced by mild sweetness.

Piraat Ale

Style: Belgian Tripel IPA (10.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: An everyday treat for men at sea during the 17th and 18th centuries, Piraat packs a mighty punch that offers a deep, hazy golden color with the perfect balance of hops and malt.

Poperings Hommel Ale

Style: Belgian IPA (7.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This unique beer will pour a hazy golden hue, topped with an off-white head with great retention. This has a great crisp mouth feel from the high level of carbonation, with flavors of dry malt, European hops, and a touch of orange citrus.

Rodenbach Grand Cru

Style: Belgian Wild Ale (6% ABV)

Size: 22 oz

Notes: A blend of 1/3 young beer and 2/3 of beer aged 2 years in large oak vats. The more important proportion of oak matured beer contributes to its fruity taste, complexity and intensity. The finish is worthy of a great wine.

Saison Dupont

Style: Saison (6.5% ABV)

Size: 12.7 oz

Notes: A cloudy bright golden color is covered with enormous white head. The nose picks up saaz hops, Belgian yeast, grass, and lemon zest. The flavor is very complex, a light refreshing taste of a pilsner intertwined with a Belgian Pale Ale. Flavors found in the nose are present in the taste.

Scaldis

Style: Belgian Strong Dark Ale (12.0% ABV)

Size: 8.4 oz

Notes: This beer is quite dry with a pleasantly nutty finish that comes from the roasted barley. The kettle seared sugars and clean hop finish round out this memorably warming experience.

Scaldis Blonde Triple

Style: Belgian Strong Pale Ale (10.5% ABV)

Size: 750 ml

Notes: A straw, golden hue is crowned by a huge, highly carbonated powdery white head. Bubbles raise to the surface continuously as if it were champagne. Aromas and flavors of honey, sweet malt, pepper, vanilla, lemon zest and melon are present.

Scaldis Pêche Mel

Style: Fruit Lambic (8.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: A caramel colored body is topped by a full, fluffy white head. This is fermented with peaches, and it is very apparent in both the smell and taste. The finish will also display flavors of sweetened malt, hints of coconut, cream soda and German Riesling.

St. Bernardus Abt 12

Style: Belgian Quadrupel (10.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: A dark ivory colored beer with a high fermentation is the show piece of the brewery. Thanks to its soft and unconditionally genuine aroma, the beer can be smoothly tasted and has a very fruity flavor.

St. Bernardus Tripel

Style: Belgian Abbey Tripel Ale (8.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This has a pale amber color with a wonderful head, slightly sweet aroma of rosewater, and the orangey-grassy flavor of Styrian hops in the finish. This is one of the finest offerings of the style.

St. Bernardus Wit

Style: Witbier (5.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This has a hazy vibrant yellow color, with a stable pale white head. A generous touch of citrus is present in the flavor, with the addition of wheat malt, clove and coriander.

Tripel Karmeliet

Style: Tripel (8.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: The color is just to the orange side of amber with a solid but small head. Let it rest for a minute to let all the flavors come out, and just enjoy the sight and smell. The taste is even more complex than the aroma.

Troubadour Blond

Style: Belgian Pale Ale (6.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: The clear, golden color it has strikes you first, then it is crowned by a fluffy white head. The first sip will leave a refreshing, sparkling effect on your palate, followed up by mild bitterness and spice, with a sweet finish.

Troubadour Magma

Style: Belgian IPA (9.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: Magma pours a hazy orange sunburst color worthy of its name, with a dense white head to top it all off and thick lacing down the sides of the glass. On the nose, there is a sugary sweetness accompanied by a bountiful floral hop aroma. Up front is the soft, sweet introduction of a Tripel followed by a flavorful wave of hop bitterness. The bitterness fades out evenly on the palate and slides right into a drying finish that exits neither too sweet nor too bitter. Incredibly, the aftertaste is rather clean, and it certainly makes for a beer you want to keep putting to your lips. Don't miss out on this beer!

Westmalle Dubbel

Style: Dubbel (7.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This is a dark, reddish-brown ale with a secondary fermentation in the bottle. The creamy head has the fragrance of special malt and leaves an attractive lace pattern in the glass. The flavor is rich and complex, herby and fruity with a fresh-bitter finish.

Westmalle Tripel

Style: Tripel (9.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This a very complex beer with a fruity aroma and a descent hop scent. It is soft and creamy in the mouth, with a slight bitter touch that is carried away by the fruity aroma. This is an exceptional brew that offers a great deal of finesse and elegance.

Witkap Pater Tripel

Style: Tripel (7.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This will pour a straw like color with a stable white head. Peaches and apricots are found in the aroma with flavors of lemon-pepper yeast, coriander and an herbal floral finish reminiscent of edible flowers.

Brazil

Xingu

Style: Schwarzbier (4.7%ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: An opaque, full-bodied black lager with mild bitterness. Rich and creamy with well balanced sweet notes and hints of tartness and exceptional mouthfeel. The finish is very clean and refreshing with some very slight notes of dark coffee beans.

Canada

Brasserie Dieu Du Ciel! Corne du Diable

Style: American India Pale Ale (6.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: Corne du Diable (Horn of the Devil) is red ale that expresses caramel flavors coming from the malt. These flavors are accompanied by a sharp bitterness and powerful hop aroma, thanks to dry hopping.

Brasserie Dieu Du Ciel! Dernière Volonté

Style: Belgian Blonde (6.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: A mix of Belgian and English brewing traditions. Complex flavors of hop flowers and spicy, fruity esters from our Belgian yeast are perfectly balanced with the robust flavors and aromas of malt. The finish is commandeered by an assertive aroma from dry-hopping.

Brasserie Dieu Du Ciel! Solstice d'Hiver

Style: Barleywine (9.8% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This noble winter beer is brown in color with flaming red highlights. Its taste is delicately sweet and liquor-like with a hint of burnt caramel coming from the malt and a prolonged boiling time. It is a very bitter beer with aromas of hops and alcohol, and flavors reminiscent of red fruit brought by the English-type yeast they use to ferment it.

Unibroue Blanche De Chambly

Style: Witbier (5.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This is produced from a unique blend of unmalted Quebec wheat and pale barley malt, to which spices and natural aromatics are added, along with a light hopping. The Blanche is only partially filtered so that it retains the full benefits of its natural ingredients.

Unibroue Éphémère

Style: Witbier (5.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: With a pleasant smell of ripe Granny Smith apples, this unique white ale pleases the palate with a delicate balance of fruit and spice notes and just a hint of sweetness.

Unibroue La Fin Du Monde

Style: Tripel (9.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: La Fin du Monde is a deluxe beer made by triple fermentation and a unique way of straining the yeast. With its champagne-like effervescence, it has a vigorous presence in the mouth, which accentuates its strong personality.

Unibroue Maudite

Style: Strong Red Ale (8.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: Maudite is a mahogany-colored, rich-tasting premium beer that has a distinctive, complex taste. The strong character of this beer will have a warming effect on the drinker.

Unibroue Trois Pistoles

Style: Belgian Strong Dark Ale (9% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: Brewed with four selected malts and four exotic spices, Trois Pistoles beckons with a subtle sweetness that makes it surprisingly smooth and satisfying for a beer of such complexity. The cocoa and fruit notes make this an ideal cordial companion.

Denmark

Mikkeller Big Worse

Style: American Barleywine (12.0 % ABV)

Size 12.7 oz

Notes: This is a great representation of an American Barleywine. The pour is a cloudy dark brown, with a small, off white head. The aromas are mostly of roasted malts, and sweetness, with a small bit of citrus notes, and hops bitterness. The taste is rich and much less bitter than other Barleywines. The alcohol is present, but not completely overpowering.

England

Blackthorn Cider

Style: Cider (4.7% ABV)

Size: 14.9 oz can

Notes: This is a very straight forward English hard cider. They press bittersweet cider apples to provide a distinct crisp flavor. You will get a strong fruit forward flavor with a refreshing and slightly sweet finish.

Moorhouse Blond Bitch

Style: English Pale Ale (4.5% ABV)

Size: 16.9 oz

Notes: This pours a hazy, vibrant gold which is topped by a fluffy white head that retails well. Aromas of sweet malt and grain create a refreshing bouquet, followed by flavors of honey, caramel, apple and pale malt.

Sam Smith's Nut Brown Ale

Style: English Brown Ale (5.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: A festive occasion beer, the brown ale is one of the oldest English brewing styles, mentioned in literature in the 16th century. This has a walnut like color and palate of hazelnuts with a wonderful balance of roasted crystal malt and aromatic hops.

Sam Smith's Oatmeal Stout

Style: Oatmeal Stout (5.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: Almost opaque, this stout has an unusually silky texture and a velvety palate. Roasted malts are prevalent with some chocolate notes and the taste of oats in the middle. Very light in body compared to most stouts with a bittersweet finish.

Sam Smith's Organic Raspberry Fruit Beer

Style: Fruit/Vegetable Beer (5.2% ABV)

Size: 18.7 oz

Notes: This is what it says it is; this will display fresh raspberries from start to finish. The color, aroma and taste will be nothing short of fresh berries making this the ideal warm weather treat, or dessert alternative.

Sam Smith's Pale Ale

Style: English Pale Ale (5.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: When this sparkling amber beer was produced, it was declared pale to differentiate it from porters. It has a fresh maltiness that reminds you that good beer is a product of the soil.

Sam Smith's Taddy Porter

Style: English Porter (5.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This was named for the train porters who were its original servers and consumers. Sam Smith reintroduced authentic porter to the British beer scene after an absence of more than 50 years. It has a dry, tangy character of roasted barley.

Young's Double Chocolate Stout

Style: Milk Stout (5.2% ABV)

Size: 14.9 oz (Nitro Can)

Notes: Jet black in color, off white head and a velvety smooth mouth feel makes this a great treat. Mild flavors of roasted malt are overtaken by decadent dark chocolate and vanilla.

Finland

Sinebrychoff Porter

Style: Porter (7.2%ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: If you are one that loves BIG, roasty, and complex porters with a strong bitter finish then this brew is for you. This is an extremely well done beer that is dry, smooth and as dark as night. So grab yourself a bottle and enjoy the ride.

France

Belzebuth

Style: Belgian Strong Pale Ale (13.0% ABV)

Size: 8.4 oz

Notes: This will pour a golden hazy hue, dressed with a fully carbonated white head. Aromas of potent alcohol, sweetened malt and honey are picked up, followed by flavors of candied sugar, orange zest, drunken apple and pear.

Germany

Aecht Schlenkerla Rauchbier Weizen

Style: Rauchbier (5.2% ABV)

Size: 16.9 oz

Notes: Schlenkerla smokebeer wheat is ale with light smoky aroma. As a Bavarian wheat beer, it is being brewed with a mixture of both barley malt and wheat malt. Served unfiltered with its natural haziness, this brew reaches its full aroma through bottle fermentation with fine top fermenting yeast.

Ayinger Celebrator Doppelbock

Style: Doppelbock (6.7% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: Arguably the finest, and most prestigious Doppelbock in the world today, the Ayinger is the epitome of what the style should represent. Full flavors of roasted malt and toffee are offered through a deep, mahogany brown with tan highlights, garnished by an assertive beige head.

Ayinger Weizenbock

Style: Bock (6.7% ABV)

Size: 16.9 oz

Notes: This will pour a pale brown color with a thick and creamy beige head. Malty, bready aromas are followed up by mild roasted malt, toffee, brown sugar, dried apricots, figs and toasted tree nuts in the flavor.

Bitburger Premium Pils

Style: German Pilsener (4.8% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This pours a crystal clear vibrant yellow topped by full white head. The smell and flavor represents everything you'd expect from the German Pils; grassy Bavarian hops, pale malts and lemon. Nothing is overpowering in this beer, which is why it's as drinkable as it is.

Innstadt Neues Helles

Style: Munich Helles Lager (5%ABV)

Size: 16.9 oz

Notes: A straw yellow body with great head retention. This is about as refreshing as it gets from a German brew. You will get some honey, bread, and pale malt notes with a nice drinkability. Anyone looking for a solid golden lager will feel right at home with this one.

Jever Pilsner

Style: German Pilsener (4.8% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: The light, refreshing notes of lager yeast, grain and mild malt sweetness are delivered through a yellow-golden color. A touch of noble hop will come through, but the refreshing malt backbone is more noticeable in the finish.

Julius Echter Hefe-Weiss Hell

Style: Hefeweizen (4.9% ABV)

Size: 16.9 oz

Notes: A pale, unfiltered wheat beer that pours a thick frothy head. This hazy yellowish orange beer has a flavor that entails bananas, cloves, citrus, and bubblegum. It starts off moderately sweet and finishes slightly bitter.

Köstritzer Schwarzbier

Style: Schwarzbier (4.8% ABV)

Size: 12 oz

Notes: This beer has a very deep mahogany hue with bready and lightly smoked aromas that follow through on a medium-bodied palate. This has a chewy malt character and a surprisingly clean finish where light hop bitters and smoky notes linger.

Schneider Aventinus

Style: Weizenbock (8.0% ABV)

Size: 16.9 oz

Notes: This wonderful beer has received top commendations for its perfect balance of two complex layers of flavors; the fruity spiciness brought in by the top-fermenting yeast and the notes of chocolate created by the use of crystal and dark malts.

Schneider Aventinus Eisbock

Style: Eisbock (12.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This beer comes to you from a 30 litre wooden keg. No beer created as much buzz after our line-up was introduced for Baltimore Beer Week as this bad boy. Please smell this beer before you drink it as the smell alone is something you will tell your friends about. The taste is of sweet malts, banana, clove, caramel, and toffee. Even with the high ABV it will go down dangerously smooth. This is the ideal digestive after a great dish.

Schneider Edelweiss

Style: Hefeweizen (6.2% ABV)

Size: 16.9 oz

Notes: One of the best of its style. Sturdy medium body, smooth creamy mouth feel though an ample carbonation holds everything together. Hops are nearly nonexistent and are no match for the spicy character of this brew. Malt flavor is present and has sour dough like quality to it, vague and mellow nuttiness from the yeast rounds out the beer.

Weihenstephaner Hefeweissbier

Style: Hefeweizen (5.4% ABV)

Size: 16.9 oz

Notes: Arguably the king of all hefeweizens, the Weihenstephaner will pour a cloudy yellow-golden color, topped with a bright fluffy head. Robust flavors of wheat malt, lemon citrus, clove and banana are found within every drop. Pour $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way full, swirl the bottle...and top off.

Weihenstephaner Hefeweissbier Dunkel

Style: Hefeweizen (5.3% ABV)

Size: 16.9 oz

Notes: Quite possibly one of the finest Dunkel-Weisses brewed to date, the Weihenstephaner will pour an opaque ruby-brown, topped by an aggressive clove and banana infused head. Flavors of roasted malt and spice intermingle with dark fruit, clove and banana.

India

King Fisher Lager

Style: Pale Lager (4.8%ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: Light in color with a great bold flavor that will outshine most others in its class. This is a fully matured beer with an exceptional clarity, and has a pleasantly bitter finish to it.

Ireland

Guinness Foreign Extra Stout

Style: Export Stout (7.5%ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This brew needs a little more of an introduction than its brother the original Irish dry stout. This offering from Guinness is typically found in other parts of the world. You will get a higher ABV with a strongly pronounced oak flavor. This is a brew that shows how bolder can be ohhh soo much better!

Porterhouse Oyster Stout

Style: Stout (4.8%ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: Brewed with fresh oysters. This is a smooth drinking, aromatic stout with a great roast malt character. Its full body and firm hop profile from Goldings hops give this brew a very unique flavor.

Wexford Irish Cream Ale

Style: Irish Red (5.0% ABV)

Size: 14.9 oz (Nitro Can)

Notes: Comparable to the Coventry Cream Ale, this will have more of an Irish feel to it. Fruit malt, English hops and mild toffee notes are displayed through a creamy, non carbonated body.

Italy

Birrificio Le Baladin 'Super Baladin'

Style: Belgian Strong Pale Ale (8%ABV)

Size: 750ml

Notes: This brew is the masterpiece of their brewery. It carries an intense aroma of warm flowers, apricot and banana with hints of bitter almond. The overall taste is very balanced with sweet malt, dark fruit, and hints of spices and herbs. Bravo!

Birrificio Pausa Café Tosta

Style: Specialty Ale (12.5%)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This brew has a deep ruby color with a hazelnut head. The enormous ABV is held hostage by notes of fruit, pears, cinnamon and residual sugar that give it a very distinct and bold flavor. This is a strong choice for someone looking for a great digestif after a big meal. Um...Did I mention that it is also brewed by prison inmates?? Seriously.

Japan

Hitachino Nest Espresso Stout

Style: Imperial Stout (7.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This stout has caramel, roasted black and chocolate malt which provide an explosion of coffee like flavors. The strong espresso character comes from the addition of espresso beans added to the boil. It offers notes of vanilla, dark fruit, cocoa and chocolate that form after the first sip. The appearance is heavy, pitch black in color, and ends with a big brown head.

Hitachino Nest White Ale

Style: Witbier (5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This will pour a hazy, vibrant yellow which is topped with a generous, rocky, grain engulfed head. Other aromas of citrus and coriander are present, leading into an interesting acidic, sour yet refreshingly crisp finish.

Scotland

Brewdog/Mikkeller Devine Rebel

Style: English Barleywine (2009 12.1% ABV) (2010 13.8% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: The Devine Rebel is liquid display of maturation beauty. This is an English Barleywine brewed at Brewdog in Scotland, tweaked and twisted by the brains behind Mikkeller. Sweet, malty caramel notes are backed up by a descent amount of hops and alcohol in the finish.

Brewdog Hardcore IPA

Style: Imperial India Pale Ale (9.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: Brewed in the IPA tradition, this ale takes it a step up by offering an IBU level of 140 and up. The extreme hop level is well hidden from the proper use of malt, excelling this brews balance.

Brewdog Paradox Paradox Imperial Stout (Isle of Arran)

Style: Imperial Stout (10.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This Imperial stout has been matured in specially selected Isle of Arran Malt Whisky Casks. The aging process infuses into the beer all the threatening smoke, the encapsulating peat, the Atlantic essence and raw power of Scotland's most distinctive Whiskies.

Brewdog Paradox Paradox Imperial Stout (Smokehead)

Style: Imperial Stout (10.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This is one robust, smoky, rich, heavy, vigorous, boisterous, intense, monstrous and outrageous beer. But yet for some reason it's harmoniously dynamic in flavor and uniqueness, leaving you scratching your head as to why they call this beer?

Brewdog Storm IPA (Islay Whiskey)

Style: Imperial IPA (8.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: They call it an Imperial India Pale Ale, but to sum it up it tastes like carbonated single malt scotch. This is simply incredible. Smokey peat, wood, honey, vanilla and tangy citrus fruit forms this incredibly odd India Pale Ale.

Orkney Skullsplitter

Style: Scotch Ale/Wee Heavy (8.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: The brewing of ale was a great Viking tradition which the native Orcadians readily adopted, and for centuries each farm has brewed its own special guarded recipe. This is satiny smooth in the mouth, deceptively light, and dangerously drinkable.

Williams Brothers Kelpie Seaweed Ale

Style: Scottish Gruit (4.4% ABV)

Size: 16.9 oz

Notes: Before the mid 1800's there were many Scottish coastal ale-houses which brewed their own ales made from local malted barley grown in fields fertilized with seaweed. Today, Kelpie is brewed with seaweed and organic barley to give this wholesome dark ale its distinctive malty texture and aroma of fresh sea breeze.

Williams Brothers Midnight Sun

Style: English Porter (5.6% ABV)

Size: 16.9 oz

Notes: This will pour nearly jet black, with brown undertones that form to the sides of the glass. Notes of roasted malt, oat, coffee and bitter chocolate make an appearance in the aroma and flavor.

Spain

Estrella Hijos de Rivera 1906

Style: Vienna Lager (6.5% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: Pours a light amber color with a fluffy white head. The aroma is of sweet malt and grass. This is a light and refreshing lager with flavors of floral hop, honey, and citrus fruit.

United States

California

21st Amendment Brew Free or Die IPA

Style: India Pale Ale (7.2% ABV)

Size: 12 oz can

Notes: This IPA represents the brewer's patriotic mentality, a dry-hopped India Pale Ale that has a firm backbone of malt to bring the best of both worlds. It isn't over the top hoppy, but has a flavor that makes you want snag another.

21st Amendment Back in Black

Style: Black IPA (6.8% ABV)

Size: 12 oz can

Notes: Brewed like an American IPA but with the addition of rich, dark malts, this beer has all the flavor and hop character you expect with a smooth, mellow finish.

The Bruery 3 French Hens

(Very Rare)

Style: Belgian Strong Ale (10% ABV)

Size: 750ml

Notes: The third verse of their "Twelve Beers of Christmas" saga incorporates vinous and oaky notes into bold and spicy dark ale. This is a truly exceptional addition to The Bruery's portfolio.

The Bruery Coton

(Very Rare)

Style: Old Ale (14.5% ABV)

Size: 750ml

Notes: This is a bourbon barrel aged Old Ale finished with brettanomyces. Its opaque mahogany body is overtaken by an assertive beige head. Flavors and aromas of caramel, cinnamon, fig, dates, raisin, clove, coriander and acidic lemon make this an extremely intricate sipper.

The Bruery Cuir

(Very Rare)

Style: Old Ale (14.5% ABV)

Size: 750ml

Notes: This is their third anniversary ale that brings together all of the amazing elements of the first two years. Layered with complex flavors of dark fruit, vanilla, oak, and burnt sugar, they blended a portion of both Papier and Coton that had been aging in oak barrels with this new batch of the same beer, adding an additional layer of complexity.

The Bruery Marrón Acidifié

(Very Rare)

Style: Imperial Oud Bruin (8.5% ABV)

Size: 750ml

Notes: Dark sour ale aged in oak barrels. Collaboration between The Bruery and Cigar City Brewing, this Imperial Oud Bruin is layered with aromas of cranberries, tropical fruits, leather, and aged balsamic, balanced by wood tannins and roasted malt.

The Bruery Saison Rue

Style: Saison (8.5% ABV)

Size: 750ml

Notes: This is Belgian style ale that is brewed in tribute of the changes in the seasons. They used rye and a special yeast strain called brettanomyces to provide elements of grass, spice and a light tart flavor.

Lagunitas IPA

Style: American IPA (5.7% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: Just a good IPA plain and simple. A bright sunrise orange is garnished by a full, oily and well-retained off-white head. Aromas of citrusy pine and hop create a beautiful bouquet, finished with flavors similar in the nose, alongside bready grain, light honey and a sharpness of sea salt.

Lagunitas Hop Stoopid

Style: Imperial IPA (8% ABV)

Size: 750ml

Notes: For those mornings when you have to cut right to the chase, this is the one. Sure to blast through just about anything still lingering from the night before, this mouthful of Hops and huge rich Malt has a guarantee built right into the name!

North Coast Brother Thelonious

Style: Dubbel (9.4% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: Jazz icon Thelonious Monk is the inspiration for this Belgian-style abbey ale. Like a "Belgian Dark Strong Ale", this beer is rich and robust with a full, heavy body and a sweet and slightly hoppy finish.

North Coast Old Rasputin

Style: Russian Imperial Stout (9.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: Produced in the tradition of 18th Century English brewers who supplied the court of Russia's Catherine the Great, Old Rasputin seems to develop a cult following wherever it goes. It's a rich, intense brew with big complex flavors and a warming finish.

North Coast Old Stock (2009)**(Very Rare)**

Style: Old Ale (12.5%ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: Like a fine port, Old Stock Ale is intended to be laid down. With an original gravity of over 1.100 and a generous hopping rate, Old Stock Ale is well-designed to round-out and mellow with age. It's brewed with classic Maris Otter malt and Fuggles and East Kent Goldings hops, all imported from England. This brew is easily one of the best beers that we have ever carried here at VGP!

North Coast Scrimshaw Pilsner

Style: German Pilsner (4.4% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: A well executed refreshing variation of the style, the Scrimshaw will pour a slightly hazy straw color with minimal head. Aromas of noble hops and grain malt are followed by the easy flavor profile of hallertauer and tettnang hops, with generous touches of sweet malt in the finish.

Sierra Nevada 30th Anniversary Fritz and Kens Ale

Style: Imperial Stout (9.2% ABV)

Size: 750 ml

Notes: A collaboration by two of the oldest and biggest names in the craft brewing industry; Fritz Maytag from Anchor, the godfather of brewing and Ken Grossman from Sierra Nevada joined forces and created an incredible limited release brew. This oak aged Imperial Stout will display full flavors of wood, deeply roasted malt, bitter dark chocolate and a touch of coffee.

Sierra Nevada Kellerweis

Style: Hefeweizen (4.8% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: Kellerweis is one of the only American Hefeweizens made using the traditional Bavarian style of open fermentation. This difficult and super labor-intensive technique adds uncommon depth and flavor complexity.

Sierra Nevada Stout

Style: American Stout (5.8% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: Appearance is a smooth, velvety black with a mocha colored head that retains well. Robust malt characteristics are present in the aroma as well as the taste. Semi-sweet chocolate, mild coffee and smoke are also present in the finish.

Sierra Nevada Torpedo Ale

Style: American IPA (7.2% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: The name itself comes from a device called the "hop torpedo" that was conceived, designed and developed at the brewery. The result is a revolutionary method of dry-hopping that harnesses the vital hop oils and resins that lead to an unusually flavorful and aromatic beer featuring the full, nuanced range of spicy complexity that hops have to offer.

Stone Arrogant Bastard

Style: American Strong Ale (7.2% ABV)

Size: 22 oz

Notes: A beer so aggressive in flavor that its whole purpose is to shoo away all of the light beer drinkers out there. Its 2010, people, put that dirty bath water, skunked, mass-produced, urine colored "light" beer down now! Don't drink that stuff because your friends do, or because a commercial told you to. You don't look cool, so why do it? This bad boy will pour deep, hazy burnt amber topped with an assertive beige head. Its aroma and flavor is engulfed with caramel malt and high acid hops to appease craft beer drinkers of all sorts.

Stone Oak Aged Arrogant Bastard

Style: American Strong Ale (7.2%ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: Start by Imagining the aggressive flavor that you loved about the Arrogant Bastard. Now add some more intense bitterness and a nice oaky backbone that leaves you wanting more. That will give you the basis for the delicious journey you are about to embark on.

Stone Ruination IPA

Style: Imperial India Pale Ale (7.7% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: Take one sip and you'll soon realize why this imperial IPA is respected as much as it is. They call it ruination for the "ruinous" effect it creates on your palate. Monster hops are all over the place, giving much gratitude to the hard work of the Columbus and Centennial hops.

Colorado**New Belgium Lips of Faith Clutch**

Style: Stout (9.5% ABV)

Size: 22 oz

Notes: Pure rock fury meets Belgian-style brewed folly in this collaboration with Maryland hard-rockers, Clutch. This brew contains a pronounced line of dark chocolate, coffee and black malts that compliments the slight sourness of this dark wood ale.

New Belgium Lips of Faith Kick

Style: Spiced Fruit/Vegetable Beer (8.5% ABV)

Size: 22 oz

Notes: This is the collaboration pumpkin beer that New Belgium created with the Elysian Brewing Co. It is ruby hued, slightly sour, pumpkin and cranberry ale that is an interesting take on a popular seasonal style.

Oskar Blues Dales Pale Ale

Style: American Pale Ale (6.5% ABV)

Size: 12 oz (can)

Notes: This has been described as somewhere between an American Pale Ale and an India Pale Ale. It's an assertive but balanced beer featuring a meringue-like head, a copper color, and a hoppy nose complimented with a rich middle of European malts.

Oskar Blues G. Knight Double IPA

Style: Double IPA / Imperial Red (8.7% ABV)

Size: 12 oz (can)

Notes: The Gordon is somewhere between an Imperial Red and a Double IPA. They brew this with six different malts and three types of hops, followed by a dry-hopping of Amarillo hops. It offers a floral, resinous aroma and a luscious mouth feel.

Oskar Blues Gubna

Style: Imperial IPA (10% ABV)

Size: 12 oz (can)

Notes: Ello Gubna! This puppy will pour bright gold with a fluffy off-white head. This brew is exclusively brewed with the summit hop, allowing this breed to display its full potential of flavoring a beer. Aggressive, rambunctious, full flavored and hoppy as all sin the Gubna is.

Oskar Blues Mama's Little Yella Pils

Style: Czech Pilsner (5.3% ABV)

Size: 12 oz (can)

Notes: Proud Mama of her little Yella Pils, this is arguably one of our best session beers available at the moment. This pours a standard pils color of gold and yellow, with flavors of grain, bready malt, grass and a touch of corn.

Oskar Blues Old Chub

Style: Scottish Strong Ale (8.0% ABV)

Size: 12 oz (can)

Notes: Old Chub gets a dash of beechwood-smoked grains imported from Bamberg, Germany, home of the world's greatest smoked beers. The cola-colored beer features a tan head, a creamy, milky mouth feel, and rich, semi-sweet flavors of caramel.

Delaware

Dogfish Head 60 Minute IPA

Style: American IPA (6% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: The brew that sprinkled the craze in the Dogfish cauldron, the 60 Minute is arguably one of the most popular and best India Pale Ales brewed on the east coast. A bold, rich copper hue is topped with an aggressive off-white head. Aromas of orange zest and pine are backed up by balanced notes of caramel malt, pine, citrusy hops and brown sugar in the finish.

Dogfish Head 90 Minute IPA

Style: Imperial IPA (9% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: Many call this the finest IPA brewed in America; its balance of malt and aggressive hops makes this extremely desirable. The hops are boiled for 90 minutes to bring out aromatic floral and bitter flavors to vamp up the character. The color is similar to the 60, but will pour a touch hazier, crowned by an aggressive off-white head. Sticky hop flavors dominate the palate.

Dogfish Head Midas Touch Golden Elixir

Style: Herbed/Spiced Beer (9.0% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: Complex, sophisticated, intriguing, perplexed. Is this a beer, or is this some sort of fortified wine. The color is reminiscent of hard cider, while offering notes of honey and saffron in the aroma. Strong flavors of grape, sweet barley, tangy citrus and honey are found in the finish.

Evolution Lot # 3

Style: India Pale Ale (6.7% ABV)

Size: 11.2 oz

Notes: This pours deep amber with a well-retained off-white head. The hops are present immediately up front followed by a mellow touch of grapefruit citrus and pine in the finish. Balance is the key to a great IPA which this one represents well while offering a pleasant malty finish.

Style: Old Ale (8% ABV)

Size: 16.9 oz

Notes: This is Heavy Sea's highly anticipated plank series! It is a big, malty, oaked stallion of a beer. You will get notes of vanilla, caramel malt, and a beautiful bitter finish that will leave you thanking the beer gods!

Michigan

Jolly Pumpkin La Roja

Style: American Wild Ale (7.2% ABV)

Size: 750ml

Notes: This ale will pour deep amber with earthy caramel, spice and sour fruit notes developed through natural barrel aging. The La Roja is unfiltered, unpasteurized and blended from barrels ranging in age from 2 to 10 months.

Jolly Pumpkin Weizen Bam

Style: German Hefeweizen (4.5% ABV)

Size: 750ml

White Wines by the Glass

Sofia by Coppola, Blanc de Blancs, California

Notes: This sparkling wine by the daughter of director, Francis Ford Coppola, is a blend of Pinot Blanc, Sauvignon Blanc and Muscat. Sophia "mini" has flavors of juicy pears, summer melon, and refreshing citrus and honeysuckle.

Rosemount Traminer, Riesling, Australia

Notes: Traminer Riesling is a delicious blend of two of the world's most expressive and flavor some grape varieties. Traminer has a tropical fruit aroma reminiscent of lychees and exotic scent, with a generous, soft palate. The Riesling component adds elegance to the finish, with lifted, floral flavors and a fine acidity.

Ca' Donini, Pinot Grigio, Italy

Notes: The grapes come from selected vineyard parcels in Trentino and the Veneto on very stony and well-drained alluvial soils. This delicious Pinot Grigio is full of flavor with bright notes of honey, apple and wildflowers. It is fresh, clean and lively with a pleasing, lingering aftertaste of ripe pears.

Villa Pozzi, Pinot Grigio, Italy

Notes: Soft, attractive aromatics of perfumed rose and honeysuckle with refreshing rounded fruit. This Spanish treat offers up light fruit flavors of apricot, apple and some peach mingled with some lime on the end. Each layer of flavor is very subtle which makes this wine an easy accompaniment to summer foods.

Anton Bauer "Gmork", Grüner Veltliner, Donauland, Austria

Notes: Gruner Veltliner, the most distinctive and widely grown grape in Austria, is rapidly gaining popularity elsewhere thanks to its food-friendliness and engaging complexity. It has a brilliant green lemon-gold color, rich aromas of ripe melon and a honeyed mouth feel. It is a wine with unusual depth and isn't too sweet, which is something you would typically find in this varietal.

Walnut Block, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand

Notes: A brilliant pale straw color in the glass with intense aromatic notes of tropical fruits over a grassy, herbaceous background. The palate mingles gooseberry and green tropical fruits (kiwifruit, honeydew, pineapple). Good acid structure leaves a crisp lengthy finish.

Truth, White Blend, California

Notes: 94% of this wine comes from 50 year-old Sauvignon Blanc vines. An addition of 3% Riesling and 3% Orange Muscat helps to round out the concentrated and powerful Sauvignon Blanc. Made completely in stainless steel, this wine is crisp and lively with aromas of jasmine, green apple, and lemon zest. Exceptional flavors of kaffier lime, lemon grass and sweet gooseberry deliver an exciting mouthful and very long finish.

Glen Carlou, Chardonnay, South Africa

Notes: This full bodied white will pour a light gold in the glass with a subtle greenish hue. The aroma is full and intense with a touch of butterscotch. The taste is ripe with a toasty style and rounded mouthfeel. Taste peach and fig and it has a classic buttery finish.

Daniel Gehr's, "Oak Free" Chardonnay, California

Notes: Golden straw in color with a sparkling clarity. The nose offers up medium intensity aromas of dried apples and tropical fruit supported by rich waxy lemon rind. The palate gives medium intensity with citrus and apple on a base of medium intensity minerality. The wine is crisp and zesty with a refreshing mouth feel. The finish is built around green apple backed by citrus with distinct minerality.

Red Wines by the Glass

Bridlewood, Pinot Noir, California

Notes: Unlike a lot of Pinot Noirs which can be transparent and watered down, this wine expresses the other side of the Pinot Noir spectrum. It shows off dark fruit flavors of plum and currant with nuances of vanilla and some spice. Well rounded and balanced this wine has a smooth, lingering finish.

Martin Codax, Tempranillo "Ergo" Rioja, Spain

Notes: Spanish wines are becoming more and more popular. Full fruit flavors, complexity in each layer, drinkability and affordability all help. Tempranillo from la Rioja is considered to be of the highest quality. This is a modern-style Rioja, exhibiting dark, robust, plush fruit and agreeable tannins. The Ergo Tempranillo has lots of body and structure, as well as multiple layers of fruit.

Red Diamond, Shiraz, Washington

Notes: All of the wines under the Red Diamond label are specifically designed to be approachable and easy drinking. This particular varietal is a juicy, fruit-forward Shiraz with a bit of floral spice, courtesy of a splash of Viognier. A refreshing acidity on the palate contributes to an extraordinary long finish which echoes the delicious flavors throughout.
- 15 **Red Rock “Winemakers Blend”, Red Blend, California**
Notes: This is a beautiful blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Petite Syrah. Each varietal contributes a unique characteristic to this wine, but the Petite Syrah is the key element. The addition of this varietal to the blend softens the punch of the other two varietals and allows the drinker to really enjoy the layers of rich fruit. At first sip, we knew that this was going to be a great addition to our list.
- 16 **Carlos Basso, Cabernet Sauvignon / Malbec, Argentina**
Notes: The Basso family moved from Italy to Argentina a little over 75 years ago and they have been producing estate grown wines ever since. The wine is a deep ruby color with dark cherry and blackberry on the nose. This wine carries aromas from the nose right to the palate with wonderful rich flavors of dark berries and cherries with hints of coco and spice on the smooth and refined finish.
- 17 **Cline, Red Zinfandel, Sonoma, CA**
Notes: Zinfandel is a grape that is hard to make, but when made right, it's worth the trouble. Not too spicy / Not too jammy, this wine delivers great balance and structure. With mouth coating richness and depth, this Zin has a subtle vanilla / spicy strawberry aroma and flavor mixed with a hint of dark berry. We're happy to have a great Zin back on the list just in time for some colder weather.
- 18 **Alamos, Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina**
Notes: The Alamos Malbec has a dark, blackish purple color. The nose shows ripe black fruits, black pepper spice and floral notes. The mouth feel is full yet soft and supple, with black raspberry and currant flavors mingled with notes of sweet spice and a touch of leather. The finish is long and persistent with soft, sweet tannins.
- 19 **Las Rocas, Garnacha, Spain**
Notes: All the money they saved on this bland and forgettable label they saved for the truly important stuff.... The wine inside. This is a big, powerful red that's fruit-forward in the same way Barbara Streisand is nose-forward. And speaking of noses, yours will be attacked by all the black cherry, berries and spice that pour out of glass of this red.
- 20 **Monkey Business, Merlot, North Coast, CA**
Notes: No fooling around with this one. Merlot gets a bad rap, thanks to the movie “Sideways.” But this merlot goes straight for the taste buds with its complex layers of ripe berries. The peppery nose and spicy notes make it a unique wine sure to bring out the monkey in us all. Don't be influenced by a stupid movie!
- 21 **Joseph Carr “Josh Cellars”, Cabernet Sauvignon, North Coast, CA**
Notes: Not your typical California Cabernet. This is food friendly Cab that delivers gentle oak nuances blended with rich, ripe and spicy berry flavors. Subtle black currant, licorice, dark cherry and a hint of mint mingle harmoniously on the palate backed by a medium to full body and rounded tannins.
- 22 **14 Hands, Cabernet Sauvignon, Washington**
Notes: Grapes were sourced from the best growing regions in Washington State, including the Columbia Valley, Horse Heaven Hills and the Yakima Valley. 14 Hands Cabernet Sauvignon features aromas of black currants and plums with subtle hints of cedar and dried herbs. Dark stone fruit flavors are complemented by a touch of chocolate and accentuated by fine, round tannins. Cabernet Franc, Merlot and Syrah were added to enhance the mouth feel and to add body and depth. Enjoy.

Rombauer, Chardonnay, 2010, Carneros

Style: White Wine; Full Body

Notes: Seductive aromas of peach, melon, and citrus are balanced with honeysuckle and vanilla. On the palate, flavors of pears, peaches and melons are backed with lively acidity. A nice touch of vanilla-scented oak provides an added flavor dimension.

Adelsheim, Pinot Noir, 2009, Willamette Valley, Oregon

Frog's Leap, Cabernet Sauvignon, 2007, Rutherford & Napa Valley

Style: Red Wine; Full Body (94 points)

Notes: Aromas of rich dark fruit and fresh herbs lead to flavors of plum, cedar, black cherry, and some tobacco. The finish is full and will linger long after the last course has been cleared.

Lail Vineyards, J Daniel Cuvee, Cabernet Sauvignon, 2005, Napa Valley

Style: Red Wine; Full Body

Notes: Aged in 70% new French oak barrels for 19 months, this wine is full, powerful and tannic. Aromas of freshly muddled strawberries and cherries extend to the palate complimented by soft texture and layers upon layers of fruit and bittersweet chocolate.

Robert Craig, "Affinity" Cabernet Sauvignon, 2008, Napa Valley

Style: Red Wine; Full Body (92 points)

Notes: This wine is 82% Cabernet Sauvignon, but it is also blended with small quantities of Malbec, Petite Verdot, Cabernet Franc and Merlot. There are delicious red and black fruit notes along with violet, cassis, anisette, roasted espresso and dark chocolate.

Turkey Flat Vineyards, Shiraz, 2006, Barossa Valley

Notes: Aged 23 months in a blend of old and new French and American oak, this wine almost seems that the luscious berries are infused with a coffee or mocha. This wine is focused and elegant, yet complex. This wine is layered with spice, herbs, rich currant and plum with firm tannins.

Pahlmeyer, Proprietary Red Blend, 2005, Napa Valley

Style: Red Wine; Full Body (96 points)

Full of ripe black fruit, cola, leather, and coffee up front with a finish of white chocolate and vanilla. Pair this wine with gamey meats and heavily sauced pasta, or drink it on its own.
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Tikal Amorio, Malbec (organic wine)

Style: Red Wine; Full Body

- 30 Notes: The Amorio spent 12 months in 60% new French oak and received 93 points by Robert Parker in Wine Advocate. This wine is a glass-staining opaque purple, it offers up a splendid bouquet of sandalwood, Asian spices, incense, black cherry, and blackberry. Dense, layered, and long, this packed effort has enough structure to evolve for another 4-6 years.

Stone Mason, Shiraz, Currency Creek

- 32 Notes: This is a Shiraz /Cabernet / Merlot blend which gives the wine an overall soft and approachable feel while being rich in flavor. The nose shows lots of Barossa chocolate, dark plum and hints of violet.

The Guilty, Shinas Estate, South Eastern Australia

Krug Grande Cuvee, Brut, Reims

Domaine Zind-Humbrecht, Pinot Gris, 2006

Style: White Wine; Light-Medium Body (very limited)

- 56 Notes: In 1959, when Leonard Humbrecht married Genevieve Zind, Domaine Zind-Humbrecht was born. Today Domaine Zind-Humbrecht consists of 100 acres, overseen by Leonard's son Oliver. A rich and creamy late-harvest wine, with pretty layers of quince paste, apricot jam, exotic spice and honey. Juicy acidity frames this intense white, and a pleasant smoky thread lingers on the finish. Only 130 cases made!!

Chateau Leydet-Valentin, Saint-Emilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux, 2005

Style: Red Wine; Medium Body

- 57 Notes: This vintage is very well known around the world to be one of the best years in the past decade for quality wines. This Bordeaux in particular has risen to the top of many wine enthusiasts lists because of its intense and profound color, elegant nose (plum, cherry, and toast), rich volume and long finish(candied black and red berries).

Germany

Clean Slate, Riesling, Mosel

Style: White Wine; Light Body

- 58 Notes: Each micro climate of the Mosel region add a little to this wine. Grapes from the lower region provide the mineral notes, grapes added from the middle Mosel add a hint of spice to the wine, while the upper region give this wines its fresh peach and tropical fruit flavors.

Valckenberg, Gerwurtztraminer

Style: White Wine; Medium Body

- 59 Notes: Founded in 1786, the house of P.J. Valkenberg in Worms has more than two centuries of experience in bottling and exporting fine German wines. This wine is a full-bodied, medium-dry white with a lovely aroma of roses, accompanied by flavors of ripe peach and litchi. Fruity on the front, this Gewürztraminer finishes a bit drier with notes of nutmeg, cinnamon and clove.

Weingut Wittman, "100 "Hills" Riesling, Rheinhessen (organic wine)

Style: White Wine; Light Body

- 60 Notes: Not all Rieslings are sweet. This is a great example of the diversity of the grape. Blended from several estate vineyards, this wine shows briny gravel notes which are complex and satisfying. Aromas and taste of apricot, peach and pineapple run through this slightly off-dry wine with a touch of ginger on the finish to give it lift.

Italy

Lamberti, Prosecco, Veneto

Style: Sparkling

- 61 Notes: Grapes are harvested by hand, slightly before full maturation to preserve the acidity. The grapes are immediately crushed and gently pressed. Pale yellow straw color with large bubbles and moderately sweet. Flavors of green apple and lemon zest with a light and refreshing finish.

Lamarca, Prosecco, Veneto

Style: Sparkling

Melini, Orvieto Classico, Tuscany (organic wine)

Style: White Wine; Light Body

- 63 Notes: The vineyard sits at an elevation above 1,000 feet and the soil is comprised primarily of clay. This gives the wine its true character. The color is a brilliant light straw yellow with greenish hues. The bouquet is fresh, gentle and pleasantly fruity. The taste is dry and smooth with a crisp finish. This wine is blend of Procanico, Verdello, Grechetto, Malvasia and Drupeggio.

Picco del Sole, Falanghina, Campania

Style: White Wine; Medium Body

- 64 Notes: It displays aromas and flavors of green apples and citrus along with honey and almond on the finish. Falanghina is an old white grape varietal grown today on the shores of Campania, south of the city of Naples in southern Italy. It is a late-ripening variety and thought to be an ancestor of the key grape varietal in the ancient wine Falernum or Flaernian.

Garofoli, "Serra del Conte" Verdicchio, Marche

Style: White Wine; Light-Medium Body

- 65 Notes: Verdicchio comes from the Marche region of Italy where it is responsible for white wines that are high in acid and exhibit a classic bitter almond and mineral note that compliment the grape's lemon and apple fruit. The grapes are picked as soon as ripening occurs in order to accentuate the resulting wine's fruity freshness. The wine is very elegant with ripe fruit flavors layered with honeysuckle notes that finishes light and refreshing.

Terlaner, Pinot Grigio, Trentino - Alto Adige

Style: White Wine; Light Body

- 66 Notes: Finally a Pinot Grigio that doesn't just taste like Italian spring water. This is a wine with substance, length and a nice mineral edge, along with lemon zest, white peach, apple blossom and graham cracker notes. This shows balance, and a lingering, aromatic finish.

This wine is 80% Coda di Volpe and 20% Falanghina which are both ancient Italian grape varietals which have been sipped on by the elite of Roman society, popes and politicians. Individually selected grapes are soft pressed in cold-fermented stainless steel which creates a smooth, delicate wine with an elegant mineral element.

Marziano Abbona, Viognier, Piedmont

Style: White Wine; Full Body

- 69 Notes: Viognier and Piedmont don't usually roll off the tongue in the same sentence, but this mineral-laced, yellow-apple-focused beauty also boasts honey, white pepper and apricot on the mid-palate. Pears and fresh-cut flowers abound on the steely finish, making this a classically proportioned Viognier from an unusual source.

Caruso & Minini, Sachia Perricone, Sicily

Style: Red Wine; Light Body

- 70 Notes: Caruso & Minini is one of 3 wineries in Italy still making wines from 100% Perricone wine, a grape that is typically used in blends. Also known as Pignatello, this variety creates a lovely dry red with plump dark raspberry flavors and nice acidity that creates a refreshing quality.

Castello D' Albola, Chianti, DOCG, Tuscany

Style: Red Wine; Light Body

- 71 Notes: Bright cherry, soft oak and good acidity are the main attractive points to this dry red. This is an easy drinking wine with a low alcohol content which makes it not only easy to drink, but leaves you guilt free when pouring yourself a second glass. Light tannins and forward fruit also make this wine great for groups to fit everyone's taste.

Donna Lauren "Ali", Sangiovese, Tuscany

Style: Red Wine; Light-Medium Body

- 72 Notes: This wine exhibits a fragrance of bright red cherry. The bouquet opens up further while the wine is allowed to breathe. This medium bodied red is full of juicy fruit flavors and shows off its stainless steel fermentation with soft, velvety tannins.

Dipinti "La Vis", Pinot Noir, Trentino

Style: Red Wine; Light Body

- 73 Notes: Light and sophisticated with a pure and intense aroma of fresh fruit. Big cherry and raspberry appear first on the nose followed by mellow aromas reminiscent of wet forest. On the palate this wine shows great balance and smooth tannins with a touch of spice on the finish.

Michele Chiarlo, Barbera d' Asti DOC

Style: Red Wine; Medium Body

- 74 Notes: This wine displays a complex mix of sweet fruit along with hints of truffle, smoke and leather that weave together to form an incredibly complex nose. This wine has great body, richness and the aromatic complexity continues on the palate yet is

very well balanced in a classic Barbera style.

Sella and Mosca, Cannonau di Sardegna Riserva, DOC, Sardinia

Style: Red Wine; Medium Body

- 75 Notes: 100% Cannonau which is a direct ancestor of the Grenache grape. Intense bright ruby in color with ripe red berry complimented by undertones of herbs, coffee and spices. This wine will drink like a full bodied Pinot Noir. It has layers of fruit with a backbone of earthy character.

Villa di Zano, Chianti Classico, DOCG

Style: Red Wine; Light-Medium Body

- 76 Notes: A true expression of quality in a Chianti. Grapes are pressed in small quantities and aged in stainless steel to keep their youthful qualities. This wine exhibits a classic cinnamon and spice bouquet with medium tannins and high acidity. Enjoy flavors of plum, raspberry and dark cherry. This wine is made with a traditional blend of Sangiovese, Canaiolo, and Colorino grapes.

Marcarini, Nebbiolo delle Langhe, DOC, Piedmont

Style: Red Wine; Medium Body

- 77 Notes: Wonderfully dry and tannic with a big bouquet of rose petals, dark, ripe cherries and sweet spices woven together seamlessly. The bouquet leads to a mouthful of dry raspberry and blackberry. This wine is produced from the youngest Nebbiolo-Barolo vines in the Roero region.

Cecchi, Vino Nobile di Montepulciano, 2006

Style: Red Wine; Medium Body

- 78 Notes: Cecchi employs red wine vinification at controlled temperatures for approximately 21 days. This is followed by 24 months of aging in small oak casks and an additional minimum of 3 months of bottle refinement. Intense ruby red in color, tending towards garnet with prolonged aging. The bouquet is characteristic of the varietal, an intense aroma of violet. On the palate, the Vino Nobile delivers supple tannins, balance, and wonderful structure.

Le Ragose, "Garda" Cabernet Sauvignon, 2005, Veneto

Style: Red Wine; Medium Body

- 79 Notes: North of Verona, in the town of Negrar, at the Valpolicella zone's highest point (1,148 feet), the Le Ragose estate overlooks gentle, lush green hills. The vines peak through the winter fog which are ideal growing conditions for the grapes grown here. Although Cabernet Sauvignon is grown in small amounts on the vineyard, the grapes that are harvested and pressed produce a wonderful wine. With aromas and tastes of grilled herbs, leather, olive and blackberries, this wine will be sure to give your taste buds a pleasant surprise.

Masi, Costasera, Amarone

Style: Red Wine; Medium-Full Body

- 80 Notes: Liquid Velvet. This is a bottle that once you open it, you will finish it. Tell your friends to get another bottle because this one is yours. Deep, dark ruby red with thin violet tinges on the edges. Strong bouquet of baked fruit, plums and cherries, which provide the fruit flavors on the palate and are accompanied with attractive hints of coffee and cocoa. Excellent balance between supporting acidity and soft tannins that melt into an intriguing softness. Imposing structure and good alcoholic level gives this Amarone an attractively long finish. 90 points from the Wine Advocate and 91 points from the Wine Spectator.

Azienda Collefrisio, "Zero" Montepulciano D' Abruzzo,

Style: Red Wine; Full Body

- 81 Notes: Deep red/purple color. Full aromas of raspberry, red licorice and some fresh herbs and toast. Full bodied with fresh fruit, chewy tannins, fresh acidity and some oak. A medium long finish that is slightly drying.

Italy Cellared Selections

Fontanafredda Serralunga D'Alba, Barolo, DOCG 2004, Italy

Style: Red Wine; Full Body

- 82 Notes: Good, rich and quite complex wine with a full body. Decanted it 2,5 hours. The nose is quite perfumed with elements of dark cherry. The mouth is rather powerful yet smooth, with good acidity, cherry and hints of oak and tobacco. Quite long finish showing some power and complexity.

Marziano AbbonaPressenda, Barolo, DOCG 2004, Italy

Style: Red Wine; Full Body

86 Notes: Named after a traditional Portuguese folk dance; this wine combines four of Portugal's classic varietals, Tinta Roriz, Tinta Borroca, Touriga Franca and Touriga Nacional. This blend of grapes offers a pleasant balance of vanilla, cherry and some acorn. This wine is very bright and easy drinking which makes this an everyday wine.

- Vina Mein, 7 Grape Varietal, Ribeiro**
Style: White Wine; Medium Body
87 Notes: The name Ribero means 'riverside' which aptly defines the grape-growing landscape of the region - most of its vineyards are located on the banks of the Miño river on valley floors and steep terraces. It was established as a DO (Denominación de Origen) in 1957. This wine pours a clear gold color and has fresh quince and green apple skin aromas. The palate is bright and tart with a good fleshy palate. Refreshing stuff!
- Marques de Caceras, Rioja**
Style: Red Wine; Medium Body
88 Notes: The color is the first thing that catches your eye, attractive and bright ruby-red. The aromas are a mix of Mediterranean herbs with blackberries and black cherries. Sip the bright raspberry, cherry and strawberry flavors with a touch of cinnamon. Sit back and enjoy the subtle tannins and long finish. Truly a great Spanish wine!
- Abadia de San Campio, Albarino, Galicia, DO**
Style: White Wine; Medium Body
89 Notes: The wine is bright and clear in color and boasts aromas of citrus fruits, pineapple and lemon which fill the nose. On the palate shows an amazing ripe fruit sensation. This crisp white wine maintains a fantastic balance of acidity and fruit. This wine was shown lots of love, both by mother nature and by the winemaker.
- Legaris, Crianza, DO Ribera del Duero**

90 Notes: Deep cherry with violet hues in the glass. Over forty different clones and selections of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay are planted on the 340-acre estate in the Sonoma Carneros district which allows the winemaker to consistently produce Cuvées with complexity and clear fruit expression.
- Tu Tu, Pinot Grigio, Napa Valley, California**
Style: White Wine; Light Body
94 Notes: Heady floral aromas of melon, pear, apricot and nectarine, give way to flavors of fig, ripe melons, and bright lemon peel. Lush fruit flavors on the mid-palate are complemented by classic slate minerality, all framed in crisp, refreshing natural acidity.
- Montinore, Almost Dry Riesling, Willamette Valley, Oregon**
Style: White Wine; Light Body
95 Notes: The Almost Dry offers a beautiful aroma of lime, fresh flowers and tangerine with hints of lilac. On the palate it has an elegant, almost silky yet fresh entry with flavors of grapefruit accented with mandarin and tangerine. The finish shows the refreshing, palate cleansing acidity with an almost imperceptible sweetness that accents the lingering citrus and mineral flavors.
- Adelsheim, Auxerrois, Oregon**

96 Notes: Pronounced (ohk-sair-wah), this grape arrived from Alsace to Oregon in 1977. Although it is primarily used for blends, this grape when used by itself, it has unbelievable purity. When the Auxerrois grape becomes fully ripe, the resulting wine takes on aromas of quince, Asian pear and honey. A subtle minerality is present, followed up by great structure and backbone.
- St. Clement, Sauvignon Blanc, Napa Valley**
Style: White Wine; Light-Medium Body
97 Notes: This Sauvignon Blanc opens with floral aromas, ripe green apple, guava and melon with hints of pineapple and orange zest on the nose. The palate is tropical and complex yet clean and balanced. A harmony of fruit flavors reveal themselves in this
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wine, from yellow apple, lemon curd and meringue to yellow citrus, stone fruits and pear and white peach at the finish.

Pacific Rim, Chenin Blanc, Columbia Valley, Washington State

- 98 Notes: Pacific Rim is known for the wonderful Rieslings that they produce, but it is not the only wine that they do well. This Chenin Blanc is a great food wine. - 99 Notes: This wine is an aromatic combination of Northwest coastal breezes and definitive orange-blossom, rose water and ripe peaches. Accents of the perfect perfume of gardenias and sweet spices make this a glorious example of fine Oregon Pinot Gris. Richly textured and flavorful, the wine delivers weight on the palate that is nicely balanced by citrus notes and fresh acidity.

Ferrari-Carano, Fume Blanc, Sonoma County, California

Picture a Bellini combined with a Mojito. Got it? Good. That's what you get with this wine. A peachy, minty, fresh wine with a hint of lime. If you are tired of the same old Chardonnay, but still looking for a full bodied white wine, then try this varietal. You won't be disappointed!

Evolution, Sokol Blosser, Willamette Valley, Oregon

Style: White Wine; Full Body

- 103 Notes: Unlike a lot of blends, Evolution presses 9 different wine varietals separately, so that each one can bring character to the wine. Each vintage will, of course, taste different from the last, but each year a new great wine is produced. The 9 grapes tie together perfectly, creating a smooth, layered white wine that can hold its own or stand up to just about any food pairing you dare to serve it with.

Bonterra Vineyards, Roussanne, Mendocino County, California (**organic wine**)

Style: White Wine; Medium Body (very limited)

- 104 Notes: The winemaker ferments this wine entirely in stainless steel, without malolactic fermentation while leaving the wine in neutral oak for eight months to rest and gain complexity. Aromas of fresh Granny Smith apples and Bartlett Pears are joined by ripe harvest peaches offered by the Viognier in the blend. There are also hints of honey and almond which give way to exotic floral notes of jasmine on a summer breeze. The wine is crisp and fresh, with some Muscat to lift up the aromatics.

Caymus, Conundrum, Napa, Monterey, Santa Barbara, California

Style: White Wine; Full Body

- 105 Notes: A conundrum is a puzzle. So why call this wine a conundrum? They keep you guessing. Each vintage is a blend of wine varietals from all over California and each new year the winemakers make this table wine, they change the percentage of how much of each varietal is used in each bottle. So, what is that wonderfully robust, floral and bright tropical taste? Is it green apple, tangerine or honeysuckle? Could it possibly be apricot, melon, pear or light vanilla? That's the Conundrum.

Stags' Leap, Viognier, Napa Valley, California

Style: White Wine; Full Body

- 106 Notes: Viognier has been used as part of the final Petite Syrah blend for the past fourteen years, but it wasn't until 1998 that the wine found its own bottle. The Viognier features luscious aromas of fresh pear, guava, honeysuckle and orange blossom. On the palate, flavors of tangerine, pear and lime zest are wrapped around a rich, unctuous texture. The exceptionally long finish is punctuated by a vibrant acidity and notes of white peach and lemon blossom.

Sonoma Cutrer, "Les Pierres" Chardonnay, Sonoma County, California

- 107 Notes: This wine is made in very limited quantities and is rarely available outside the winery show room. The wine makers take extra special care of these grapes using a "Grand Cru" approach to the harvesting, pressing and fermenting. The vines are found in a dried up river bed with gravelly clay soils which are at the root (no pun intended) of the wines unique character. Rose petal, honey comb, lime zest and Granny smith apple are all found mingled with strong minerality and a flinty frame.

Montinore, Pinot Noir, Willamette Valley, Oregon

Style: Red Wine; Light Body

- 108 Notes: This has a dark garnet color with a brick rim. It is very aromatic for a young wine with notes of Black raspberry, blackberry, toasted hazelnuts and hints of forest floor. On the palate the ripe blackberry coats your mouth supported by firm but fine grained tannins and accented with flavors of Bing cherry, roasted nuts and hints of toast, fresh berries and spice.

- Babcock “Rita’s Earth”, Pinot Noir**, Santa Ynez Valley, Barbara County, California
Style: Red Wine; Light Body
- 109 Notes: Not too heavy; not too light. Hold the glass up to the window and you’ll see just enough light pass through showing off the wines brilliant color. The mouth is full of cherries and spice that lies somewhere between nutmeg and ginger, which has become a very welcome standard to the Pinot’s from Babcock winery.
- Sonoma Cutrer, Pinot Noir**, Sonoma Coast, California
Style: Red Wine; Light Body
- 110 Notes: Intense ruby red color this is light bodied, fruit forward wine. You may notice some allspice, cedar, a touch of oak and some black currant on the nose. Blackberries, raspberries and blueberries are all present in each sip. This wine is very well balanced and incredibly complex for a Pinot. We suggest that you decant this wine to enjoy each layer of flavor.
- Soter “North Valley”, Pinot Noir**, Willamette Valley, Oregon
Style: Red Wine; Light-Medium Body
- 111 Notes: The goal for the North Valley wines is to create world-class, sustainably produced Pinot Noir that reflects the inherent purity and delicacy that typify the wines from this corner of the world. Red Cherry and Black raspberry dance in harmony with a gripping minerality and lively spice. This wine benefits from decanting as the air gives it some body and clarity.
- Bricco, Sangiovese**, Columbia Valley, Washington
Style: Red Wine; Light Body (very limited)
- 112 Notes: An expression of Eastern Washington’s warmer climate, this Sangiovese offers intensely ripe notes of cherry, red licorice, orange peel and barrel spice. A soft and concentrated entry of black cherries and leather gives way to ripe tannins and a lingering finish. This is a hidden gem on our list that you will have a hard time finding anywhere else.
- Palmina, Dolcetto**, Santa Barbara County, California
Style: Red Wine; Light Body
- 113 Notes: Translating into English as “little sweet one”, Dolcetto makes brightly colored wines, reddish-purple in hue, with aromas of blackberries and plums. On release, they are generally wonderfully fruity, with soft tannins. Mineral-accented aromas of red berries and cherry, with complicating herb and floral qualities. Sappy and focused, offering bitter red fruit flavors and a hint of anise. The mineral note returns strongly on the finish, which is taut, lively and very persistent.
- Silverado Vineyards, Sangiovese**, Napa Valley
Style: Red Wine; Light-Medium Body
- 114 Notes: This wine changes with the climate more than many other grape varietals. The winemakers at Silverado decided to add a touch of Cabernet Sauvignon from Stags Leap to add some body and structure. This is a wonderful wine with abundant aromas of perfectly ripe cherry, earth, vanilla, green tea and clove. Loaded with juicy flavors of cranberry, smoke and a touch of caramel on the finish.
- Arcadian, Syrah**, Santa Ynez, California
Style: Red Wine; Medium-Full Body
- 115 Notes: Bright red. Spicy red berry and cherry aromas are sharpened by white pepper and zesty minerality. Fleishy and subtly sweet, with bright strawberry and cherry flavors with a gentle cola quality on the finish. Reminiscent of a northern Rhone wine. Finishes with brisk persistence and lingering sweetness.
- Daniel Gehr’s, Syrah**, Santa Barbara, California
Style: Red Wine; Medium-Full Body
- 116 Notes: With 1,400 acres planted Santa Barbara County is among the top six Syrah producing counties in California and with good reason: the variety thrives here. The Syrah has a complex aroma of wild blackberries, a damp forest and wild mushrooms infused with a smoky-sweet French oak. Flavors of blackberry and spice are smooth and balanced with mild tannins.
- Pavilion, Merlot**, Sonoma County, California

- 117 Notes: The 2008 Merlot is dark with deep, rich dark fruit loaded with condensed plum, black cherry and currants. The palate is rich with explosive flavor of blackberries followed by soft, ripe tannins and hint of toasted French oak to complete its elegant finish. A classic Sonoma County offering.
- Alexander Valley, Cabernet Franc**, Alexander Valley
Style: Red Wine; Medium Body
- 118 Notes: There’s big blueberry and mocha flavors here along with a bit of black olive and some earthiness. This wine will drink great upon release or can be cellared for up to five years. Like Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc loves to be paired with red meats. But because the wine is less tannic, Cab Franc is often more versatile than its more regal cousin.
- Hedges Family Estate, CMS Red Blend**, Columbia Valley, Washington State
Style: Red Wine; Medium-Full Body
- 119 Notes: CMS Red combines elegance and historic blending practices with top quality vineyard sources in the Columbia Valley. A mixture of red fruits with a little earth, wood and spice on the nose. The palate shows sour-cherry, ripe blackberry, cranberry, toasty oak, dried herbs, cracked peppercorns and enough tannin to give a surprisingly lengthy finish.
- Avalon, Cabernet Sauvignon**, Napa Valley, California
Style: Red Wine; Full Body
- 120 Notes: You can tell that the winemaker put a lot of TLC into this one. The deep rich color is the first indication of the wines depth. The wine exhibits aromas of black cherry, raspberry and mint along with hints of vanilla and short bread cookies from the barrel aging. The tannins are what you expect from a good Cabernet, round and chalky.
- Truth, Red Blend**, Santa Rosa, CA
Style: Red Wine; Full Body
- 121 Notes: Truth Red or (Lindsey’s Cuvee) is a northern California blend of 59% Syrah, 24% Malbec, 12% Cabernet Sauvignon, 2% Petite Verdot, 2% Petite Sirah, and 1% Merlot. It has aromas of grilled bread, leather and dark sweet berry and a super rich

pallet, with a very long finish.

Artezin, Red Zinfandel, Mendocino, California

Style: Red Wine; Medium-Full Body

- 122 Notes: Buyer be warned: this zin is not for the faint of palate. Big bodied and lots of spice, this zin is the epitome of what a California zinfandel is all about. This is a tooth staining, 14.8% doozy! You can definitely sip on this wine without enjoying it with any food, but if you choose to wine AND dine, then make sure you pick something hearty.

Black Ankle, Red Blend, Maryland

Style: Red Wine; Full Body

- 123 Notes: The Rolling Hills exhibits a dense ruby/plum color with a nose of black fruits, dark chocolate, and hints of tobacco and licorice. In the mouth the Rolling Hills reveals an abundance of cassis, blackberry jam, and sweet, velvety tannins leading to an extraordinarily smooth finish.

St. Clement, Merlot, Napa Valley, California

Style: Red Wine; Medium Body

- 124 Notes: This Merlot opens with aromas of blackcurrant, milk chocolate and raspberry jam. The palate follows through with rich flavors of cranberry, black cherry, anise and dark chocolate with a hint of smoky oak. The grapes for this Merlot were aged in 100 percent French oak for 19 months before blending and bottling.

Mt. Eden Vineyards, "Saratoga Cuvee" Cabernet Sauvignon, Santa Cruz, California
